

2023 Cottage Tour FAQ's

1. Where can I find out what locations/addresses are on the tour?

We don't release the locations/addresses until 12pm on Saturday, September 9th when the tour starts to ensure homeowner privacy.

2. Where can I pick-up a map?

On Saturday, September 9th no earlier than 12pm, you can present your ticket(s) at either one of two booth locations: Cannon Beach History Center & Museum (1387 South Spruce Street) or at the Tolovana Wayside (the big parking lot at the south end of town).

3. What area will the tour be in?

This year since it is the 20th anniversary of the Cottage Tour, the homes will be spread out throughout town featuring homes from past years. The homes be in Tolovana to the Presidential Streets.

4. Will a shuttle be provided?

Yes! Suzanne Elise has generously provided a shuttle for the tour this year to ease the amount of walking as the tour locations are spread out. Shuttle information will be provided in the map and will stop at three points on the tour including the bus stops both in Tolovana and in mid-town.

5. Are the homes wheelchair accessible?

No, these homes are all privately owned and are not ADA accessible. Many of these homes have multiple steps and stairways.

6. If I am unable to make it this year and already bought a ticket, can I get a refund?

Since this is a fundraiser, no refunds are available. Please call us at 503-436-9301 and we can help assist in moving your tickets to the next year.

7. Where can I park?

Parking in Cannon Beach is minimal, so we suggest arriving early to secure a parking spot. There are several parking lots in town that can be utilized including the Tolovana Wayside State Park, Gower Street parking, the Cannon Beach Community Church parking lot, and the parking lots in downtown by the Chamber of Commerce.

8. Can I take photos?

We ask that you do not take photos to respect homeowner privacy, however, there may be a homeowner or two that may encourage you to take photos, and that is okay. :)

9. Can I touch things in the home?

We ask that you be respectful and do not sit on furniture, open drawers, cupboards, ask to use the restroom, etc. We also ask that you do not eat or drink in the homes. If needing to use the restroom, please refer to the map on where the restrooms will be located.

10. Can I bring my pet?

No pets are allowed on the tour. Thank you for understanding.

11. Do I need to take my shoes off when entering each home?

You are welcome to take your shoes off when entering the home, however, there will be shoe covers that will be provided for you to use. We ask that these be reused at each location to help conserve use, and don't walk outside with the shoe covers on.
