

# 2024 Cottage Tour FAQ's

## 1. Where can I find out what locations/addresses are on the tour?

We don't release the locations/addresses until 12pm on Saturday, September 14th when the tour starts to ensure homeowner privacy.

## 2. Where can I pick-up a map?

On Saturday, September 14th no earlier than 12pm, you can present your ticket(s) at either one of two booth locations: Cannon Beach History Center & Museum (1387 South Spruce Street) or at the Coaster Theatre (108 N. Hemlock St.)

## 3. What area will the tour be in?

This year, the homes will be in the Presidential Streets and behind the area of the Coaster Theatre.

## 4. Will there be a tour guide?

The Cannon Beach Cottage Tour is a self-guided walking tour and there are no tour guides. There are volunteer docents at each of the homes that will greet and welcome you into the house. Please make sure to have your map ready when you get to the house as it is your ticket inside each home location.

## 5. Will a shuttle be provided?

We are working to confirm a shuttle will be available. Although the homes are in close proximity, we are hoping to have a shuttle provided for those with mobility issues.

## 6. Are the homes wheelchair accessible?

No, these homes are all privately owned and are not ADA accessible. Many of these homes have multiple steps and stairways.

## 7. Do you offer refunds?

Since this is a fundraiser, no refunds are available. Please call us at 503-436-9301 so we can assist you with options.

## 8. Where can I park?

Parking in Cannon Beach is minimal, so we suggest arriving early to secure a parking spot. There are several parking lots in town that can be utilized including the Tolovana Wayside State Park, Gower Street parking, the Cannon Beach Community Church parking lot, and the parking lots in downtown by the Chamber of Commerce.

## 9. Can I take photos?

We ask that you do not take photos to respect homeowner privacy, however as these are all private homes. However, there may be a homeowner or two that may encourage you to take photos, and that is okay. :)

## 10. Can I touch things in the home?

We ask that you be respectful and do not sit on furniture, open drawers, cupboards, ask to use the restroom, etc. We also ask that you do not eat or drink in the homes. If needing to use the restroom, please refer to the map on where the restrooms will be located.

## 11. Can I bring my pet?

No pets are allowed on the tour. Thank you for understanding.

## 12. Do I need to take my shoes off when entering each home?

You are welcome to take your shoes off when entering the home, however, there will be shoe covers that will be provided for you to use. We ask that these be reused at each location to help conserve use, and don't walk outside with the shoe covers on. We also ask that you do not wear high heels as this is a walking tour.
